Pennsylvania Performing Arts on Tour (PennPAT) has created a new website that features detailed information about 94 professional Pennsylvania performing artists and performing arts groups approved for inclusion in the PennPAT Artist Roster. In addition, the site includes information for both artists and performing arts presenters about how to apply for grants through the PennPAT program. A list of upcoming performances taking place across the state, that have been awarded funding through the PennPAT program, is also featured on the website.

Pennsylvania Performing Arts on Tour (PennPAT) is a program that supports the touring of professional Pennsylvania performing artists within Pennsylvania. Its purpose is to provide income and development opportunities for professional Pennsylvania performing artists through increased access to and engagement with audiences in communities throughout the Commonwealth.

The PennPAT program, administered by Mid Atlantic Arts Foundation, was developed and funded in a unique partnership between the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, a state agency, and three private philanthropies – the Vira I. Heinz Endowment, the William Penn Foundation and The Pew Charitable Trusts.
